### Who is INGEDE?

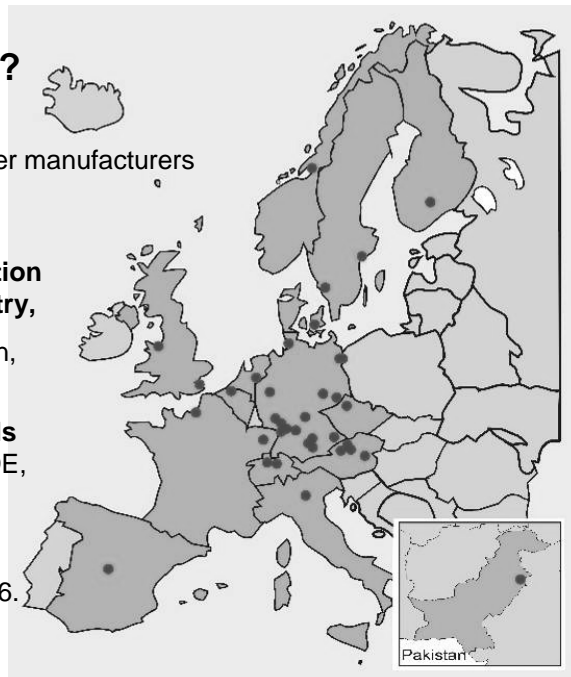
Leading European paper manufacturers

Currently **37 paper mills**  
are members of INGEDE,

who utilised about  
**10.5 Mio tons** of  
recovered paper in 2006.



## Objectives of INGEDE

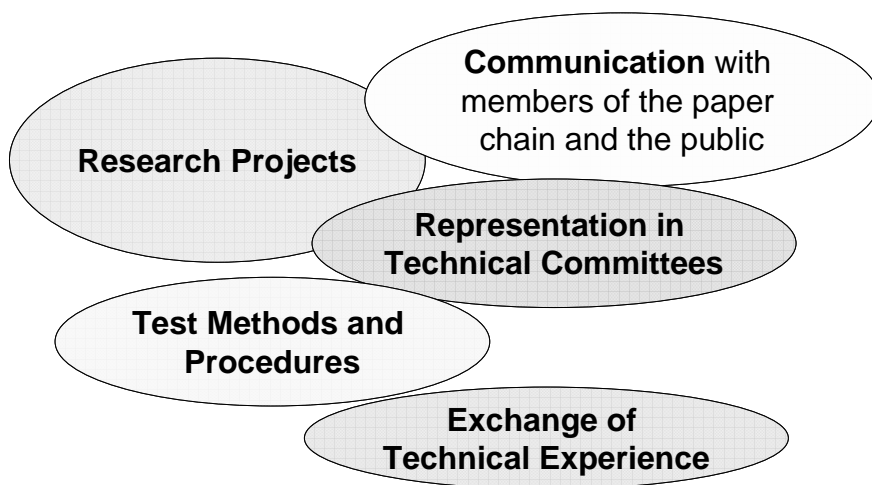


“For improving the necessary supply of recovered graphic paper for the paper industry and to avoid an increasing role of legislation it is important that

- the paper industry defines, supports and coordinates the necessary research activities in the field of deinking and
- to seek the cooperation with all other members of the paper chain.”

## European Declaration on Paper Recycling



- **Target recycling rate:  $66 \pm 1.5\%$  by 2010**
- **Qualitative targets for recyclability and paper collection systems**
- **Six associations from paper & converting industry, printing, recovered paper trade are committed to the quantitative and qualitative targets**
- **Seven associations of the publishing sector and of suppliers to printers & converters support the qualitative targets**
- **The EU acts as observer**
