

INGEDE Symposium 2009



On 29 Jan 2009 the 18th INGEDE Symposium took place in Munich at Haus der bayerischen Wirtschaft. This year's conference was themed „20 years INGEDE – 20 years of Joint Competence in Paper Recycling“. INGEDE had the pleasure to welcome the increasing number of 97 participants, 57 members, 18 representatives from research institutes and 22 invited



guests from the paper chain.

Dr. Erwin Krauthauf, former Chairman of INGEDE gave an interesting presentation on the development and history of INGEDE during these 20 years. Dr. Ulrich Höke, present Chairman of INGEDE, followed with actual information on INGEDE's 20th business year. Subsequently papers were given on the recent INGEDE research projects and the working group „Recovered Paper Quality“. Thomas Erdmann presented the new concept of the Reco-

vered Paper Sorting Plant at Stora Enso Sachsen. CTP contributed with a paper on quality control of recovered papers and boards. Furthermore Helmut Berger introduced WEPA a tissue manufacturer and new member of INGEDE. To underline his presentation he distributed some useful product samples.

To point up INGEDE's activities in terms of digital prints, we had speakers coming from the USA especially for the Symposium. Don Burns and Nils Miller presented the Digital Print Deinking Alliance (DPDA) to the audience.

Unfortunately two presentations had to be dropped due to a lack of time. One of them „Deinkability of Offset Prints“ will be presented by

General Assembly 2009

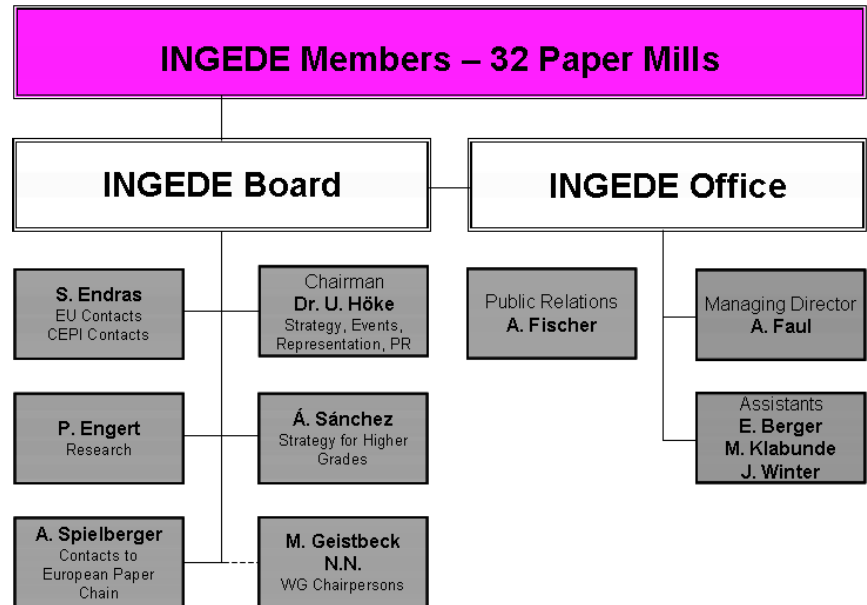
In 2009 there are several changes in the constitution of the INGEDE Board.

Walter Pillwein from UPM Kymmene Austria stepped back from his position since he will retire in March 2009. Howard Burvill changed job inside Norske Skog and went back to Australia. Therefore he can no longer fulfil his tasks in the Board.

The members of the Board proposed Peter Engert from UPM Kymmene Research (Augsburg) and Andreas Spielberger from Norske Skog Bruck to the General Assembly.

The General Assembly confirmed the constitution of the board with these two changes. Peter Engert will be responsible for research projects and Andreas Spielberger will take over the task of "Contacts to the European Paper Chain".
